RESOLUTION NO. 26-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, MODIFYING RESOLUTION NO. 35-74 DULY ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON OCTOBER 7, 1974, BY INCREASING THE CITY OF MESQUITE'S MATCHING SHARE TO \$9,917.78, IN LIEU OF THE \$9,748.03 INITIALLY AUTHORIZED, FOR THE PURCHASE OF PHASE II LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the close proximity of Police Channel 1 antenna to Police Channel 2 antenna creates severe interference problems by desensitizing the receiver on one channel when the transmitter is keyed on the other channel; and

WHEREAS, the interference problem can be corrected by relocating one of the antennae to a more distant site; and

WHEREAS, the Channel 2 antenna can be moved to the Rosabelle Water Tower at a cost of \$679.00; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Criminal Justice Division will provide 75% of the funding and the City of Mesquite's cost will be only 25% of the funding which equals \$169.75;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City of Mesquite desires to relocate the Police Channel 2 radio antenna to the Rosabelle Water Tower.

Section 2. That Resolution No. 35-74 is hereby modified to substitute the amount "\$9,917.78" for the amount "\$9,748.03" previously authorized.

Section 3. That the City of Mesquite understands that the Texas Criminal Justice Division is providing 75% of the funding for the relocation of the antenna.

Section 4. That all other provisions of Resolution No. 35-74 remain in full force and effect.
