WHEREAS, there is little or no expectation that the sub-contractor that employed such employees or Delk Construction Company, the prime contractor, will settle this amount; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City staff is hereby authorized and empowered to compromise and settle this account for the sum of \$12,505.56 and to execute the necessary documents to effect same.

SECTION 2. It is further resolved that the City of Mesquite respectfully requests of the Department of Labor that any of the funds not paid out to affected employees within the statutory period be paid over to the City of Mesquite at the end of such period.
