WHEREAS, the State Sales Tax, of which one cent is allocated by the State of Texas to cities is a major source of revenue for cities of this state; and


WHEREAS, the constant increase in the cost of municipal services places an ever increasing burden upon the ad valorem tax revenue; and


WHEREAS, the State Sales Tax is a more equitable distribution of the cost of services;
