RESOLUTION NO. 14~76

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE CONSTRUCTION OF COOPER LAKE AND CHANNELS, TEXAS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NEW ORLEANS CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND APPROVED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES IN 1955; AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is a member city of the North Texas Municipal Water District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, in Dallas County, Texas, said city being a member city of the North Texas Municipal Water District, do hereby resolve that it is to the best interest of our city that Cooper Lake and Channels, Texas, Project as recommended by the New Orleans Corps of Engineers and subsequently approved by the Congress of Corps of Engineers and subsequently approved by the Congress of the United States in 1955, be constructed at the earliest possible moment.

SECTION 2. Further, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is opposed to the payment for purchase of wildlife habitat mitigation areas through increased water bills on the sale of Cooper water.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
