A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS CALLING UPON MEMBERS OF THE CONGRESS TO EXPEDITE FUNDING FOR TITLE VI OF THE COMPREHENSIVE EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ACT

WHEREAS, HR12987 has extended Title VI of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act, and

WHEREAS, funds for this worthwhile project have not been appropriated, and

WHEREAS, present funding is to be fully expended by late October, and

WHEREAS, due to fiscal restraints, the City of Mesquite presently expects to substantially reduce personnel during the month of October, and

WHEREAS, if funding for Title VI is not expedited, the City of Mesquite faces the dual prospect of a substantial reduction in personnel and the termination of twenty-six (26) Title VI employees during the month of October with the result that the unemployment picture will be adversely affected and individual employees will face unnecessary hardships.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas calls upon the members of the National Congress to make every effort to expedite the appropriation of funds for Title VI of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act to the end that new funding will be available before the expiration of current funding and no layoffs will be required due to lack of funds.

SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be made available to members of the Congress from this area to show our concern for this vital matter.

SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
