NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS.


SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite does hereby express its deep appreciation to members of the Capital Improvement Bond Program, to wit:


And say thank you to each and every member for their work and efforts in this important task.
