RESOLUTION NO. 3-77

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held on January 15, 1977, for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

FOR Adoption of the State Law applicable to Policemen and Firemen which establishes collective bargaining when a majority of the affected employees favor representation by an employees' association and which preserves the prohibition of strikes and lockouts and provides penalties therefor.

AGAINST Adoption of the State Law applicable to Policemen and Firemen which establishes collective bargaining when a majority of the affected employees favor representation by an employees' association and which preserves the prohibition of strikes and lockouts and provides penalties therefor.

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT after examining said returns of the election held January 15, 1977, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:
