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RESOLUTION NO. 24-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A DOWNTOWN PLANNING COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the area generally known as downtown Mesquite is experiencing deterioration in both residential and commercial areas; and

WHEREAS, a square improvement project has been identified and approved under the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to plan and coordinate the square project and future improvements in the adjacent areas to protect the investment and to assure a maximum impact on both residential and commercial improvement; and

WHEREAS, the citizens are best qualified to determine the future of their area; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of the improvements will require the participation of various public and private agencies and organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That a Downtown Planning Committee be established, representing a cross-section of those effecting and affected by downtown improvements, with initial membership to be as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, to participate in a planning workshop process to study the downtown area and to propose plans, designs, projects, and programs as appropriate to improve and rehabilitate the residential and commercial uses.

SECTION 2. That this resolution take effect immediately upon passage as the law in such cases provides.
