RESOLUTION NO. 26-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ENDORSING A COUNTY BOND IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO BE VOTED ON NOVEMBER 8, 1977, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Dallas County has called a county bond election in the amount of \$215,000,000 to be voted on the 8th day of November, 1977; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County has not had a successful bond election since 1969, and in this growing, dynamic area it is necessary for the County to provide financing for the major road and other public needs of this area; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of Mesquite would have liked to have seen the road portion of the bond election increased to provide additional needed road projects for this district, but still believes the bond election to be necessary for the progressive growth and development of this area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That on this the 22nd day of October, 1977, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, does hereby endorse the propositions to be voted on by all the citizens of Dallas County on November 8, 1977, and encourage all citizens of Mesquite to study the proposals and vote in this coming election.


SECTION 2. That this resolution take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
