RESOLUTION NO. 10-78

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPMENT OF DRAINAGE FACILITIES IN A NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DESIGNATED AS SOUTHWEST MESQUITE DRAINAGE PROJECT (SHERWOOD FOREST) AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it has been determined necessary to acquire lands and/or easements in connection with a drainage improvement in the Sherwood Forest area designated as Southwest Mesquite Drainage Project; and

WHEREAS, these lands and/or easements to be acquired are located within a public project receiving financial assistance from Community Development Block Grants provided by Department of Housing and Urban Development and are covered by Title III (Uniform Real Property Acquisition Policy Acts of 1970); and

WHEREAS, those landowners within the Southwest Mesquite Project area affected by acquisition need to be apprised of the procedures and their rights through a uniform statement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite has thus declared a need for adoption of a uniform Real Property Acquisition Statement for transmittal of information relative to land acquisition procedures and rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council has determined that the pamphlet entitled, "When a Public Agency Acquires Your Property" published by Department of Housing and Urban Development fulfills the need for a uniform Real Property Acquisition Statement and is herewith adopted by reference.




