

RESOLUTION NO. 21-78

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESOUITE, TEXAS, EXPRESSING ITS APPRECIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, AND TO THE DISTRICT ENGINEER, DISTRICT 18, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF GROSS ROAD AND I-635 AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

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WHEREAS, the intersection of Gross Road and I-635 formerly was a cause for concern from a standpoint of safety due to visibility problems caused by variations in elevations of the roadways; and

WHEREAS, the configuration of the intersection and the proximity of Ridgeview Street and Peachtree Road did not lend itself to an efficient flow of traffic thereby creating backups during peak traffic hours; and

WHEREAS, the unique peculiarities of the intersection created particularly difficult design considerations for the District Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the engineering and installation of traffic signals at the subject intersection has significantly reduced the aforementioned safety and traffic problems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council expresses its appreciation to the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation and to the District Engineer, District 18, for the installation of traffic signals at the intersection of Gross Road and I-635 with the resultant improvement in the safety and traffic conditions.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
