SECTION 2. That the City extends its thanks and appreciation to the members of the McCullough family who have made this gift possible including Mrs. Ovelia McCullough, Max McCullough, Evlyn Wilson, Geraldine Drumwright and such others as have participated in this civic act.

SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
