RESOLUTION NO. 12-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, COMMITTING THE CITY TO PARTICIPATION IN THE COST OF THE GALLOWAY EXTENSION PROJECT IN EXCESS OF \$3,190,000.00 BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,596,000.00 PLUS AN ESTIMATED \$150,000.00 IN ENGINEERING WORK ALREADY COMPLETED AND COMMITTING TO CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSESSING BENEFITED LANDOWNERS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SET ASIDE FUNDS FOR SUCH COMMITMENT AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined the Galloway Extension Project between U.S. Highway 80 and I.H. 30 to be in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore committed to the Texas State Highway Department to arrange for construction of said project either through City funds or other funding; and

WHEREAS, the County of Dallas is in a position to fund said project in the amount of \$3,190,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite that all of the project, or substantially all of the project, be completed without further delay; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the project can be substantially completed for \$3,596,000.00 plus engineering costs; and

WHEREAS, the City has completed engineering work in the approximate amount of \$150,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite does hereby commit to the County of Dallas to participate in the Galloway Extension Project, as such project is described in certain plans on file with the City Engineer of the City of Mesquite and the office of Director of Public Works of the County of Dallas in such amount in excess of \$3,190,000.00 but not to exceed \$3,596,000.00 plus engineering work already completed in the amount of \$150,000.00, and to conduct public hearings as provided by law for the purpose of assessment of landowners specially benefited by such project not to exceed that portion of the City participation allowed by law.


SECTION 2. That City's financial commitment is absolute upon acceptance of a contract to construct said project and is not contingent upon any assessment of landowners.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to set aside funds not to exceed \$406,000.00 to meet this commitment.
