RESOLUTION NO. 13-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ENDORSING HOUSE BILL 1687 - SENATE BILL 1079 OF THE 66TH SESSION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS LEGISLATURE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Council for the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area has proposed that legislation be passed to permit the consideration of a regional transportation authority in the metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, senators and representatives from Dallas and Tarrant County introduced such permissive legislation in the 66th Session of the Texas Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the proposed legislation known as House Bill 1687 and Senate Bill 1079 has been reviewed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, subsequent minor modifications have been made by the Senate Intergovernmental Relations Committee and reflected in Committee Substitute Senate Bill 1079 which continues to meet the desires of the Regional Transportation Council; and

WHEREAS, further amendments expected to be made by Senator Bill Meier on the floor of the Senate also have the support of the Regional Transportation Council; and

WHEREAS, any other proposed amendments being offered by other cities in the region would defeat the purpose of the proposed legislation if incorporated; and

WHEREAS, the Mesquite City Council deems regional transportation to be vital to the economic growth and stability of the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council supports the passage of H.B. 1687-S.B. 1079 (C.S.S.B. 1079), with amendments to be offered by Senator Bill Meier, and urges approval of the legislation by the 66th Session of the Texas Legislature.

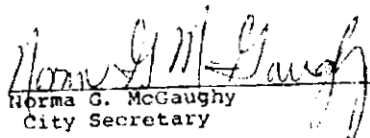
