

## RESOLUTION NO. 36-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY ESTABLISHMENT OF REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY BY CREATING ENTITIES AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Sixty-sixth Session of the Legislature of the State of Texas passed, and the Governor of the State of Texas signed into law, Senate Bill 1079, permitting the creation of a regional transportation authority in the Dallas-Fort Worth urbanized area; and


WHEREAS, the cooperation of the local jurisdictions in the Dallas-Fort Worth urban area will be vital to the implementation of a regional transportation authority in the area; and

WHEREAS, the enabling legislation allows resolutions by the principal cities in each of the two urban counties (Dallas and Fort Worth), and the commissioners courts of the two urban counties (Dallas and Tarrant) to initiate the creation process.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite encourages Dallas County and the City of Dallas, in accordance with Senate Bill 1079 passed during the Sixty-sixth Session of the Legislature of the State of Texas, the [City Council-Commissioners Court] to initiate the process for creating a regional transportation authority in the Dallas-Fort Worth metropolitan area, and to hold a public hearing on the proposal to the authority.
