A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN THE COMBINATION BEING FORMED UNDER THE CURRENT STRUCTURE OF THE DALLAS AREA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the 96th Congress of the United States has passed an act entitled "The Justice Systems Improvement Act of 1979";

WHEREAS, this Act allows units of local government to form combinations in order to receive funds directly from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration for the improvement of the local criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Area Criminal Justice Council has been established pursuant to guidelines set forth by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration and the Governor's Office. State of Texas, to coordinate local criminal justice efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee of the Dallas Area Criminal Justice Council has invited the City of Mesquite to participate in this effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby agree to participate in the combination being formed under the current structure of the Dallas Area Criminal Justice Council.

SECTION 2. That the City of Mesquite understands that this participation in the combination is binding for a period of three (3) years from October 1, 1980.
