RESOLUTION NO. 17-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE EXPRESSING SUPPORT OF A REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM TO INCLUDE THE CITY OF MESQUITE AND URGING ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE PROPOSITION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Sixty-Sixth Session of the Legislature of the State of Texas passed, and the Governor of the State of Texas signed into law, Senate Bill 1079, permitting the creation of a regional transportation authority in the Dallas-Fort Worth urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need for regional transportation for the Mesquite area in the future; and

WHEREAS, an election on this question is to be held on August 9, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite expresses its support for regional transportation and urges all eligible voters of the City of Mesquite to go to the polls on August 9, 1980, and to express their support for a regional transportation system that will include the City of Mesquite by voting in favor of the proposition.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect from its date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
