RESOLUTION NO. 22-80

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held on August 9, 1980, for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

Do you favor a cable television franchise with "R" rated movies or without "R" rated movies?

FOR "R" rated

AGAINST "R" rated

WHEREAS, immediately after said election, the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

That after examining said returns of election held August 9, 1980, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

NUMBER OF VOTES

FOR "R" Rated 4,095 AGAINST "R" Rated 2,580


It appearing that a majority of the votes were cast for "R" rated, the proposition is hereby determined to have carried.
