RESOLUTION NO. 7-81

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COURCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, A TAXING UNIT ENTITLED TO VOTE ON THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DALLAS COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT CONCERNING THE METHOD OF ALLOCATION OF THE COST OF OPERATION OF THE DALLAS COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT BY VOTING TO RETAIN THE ORIGINAL ALLOCATION OF THIRTY PER CENT (30%) EACH FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CITTES AND FORTY PER CENT (40%) FOR DALLAS COUNTY WITH A CORRESPONDING REDUCTION IN EACH GROUP'S ALLOCATION FOR THE AMOUNT ALLOCATED TO "SPECIAL DISTRICTS" AND REQUESTING EACH TAXING ENTITY TO SO VOTE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, a taxing unit entitled to vote on the appointment of members of the Board of Directors of the Dallas County Appraisal District has heretofore voted to allocate the cost of operation of the Appraisal District on a basis of thirty per cent (30%) each for cities and school districts and forty per cent (40%) for Dallas County; and

WHEREAS, it has subsequently been determined that other taxing entities called "special districts" will be required to contribute to the cost of operation of said Appraisal District;

WHEREAS, it must be determined now such additional revenue shall be distributed among those committed to pay the cost of operation of said Distribt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite is of the opinion that the revenue from the "special districts" should be equitably distributed to reduce the contribution of cities, school districts and counties on the agreed upon basis of thirty per cent (30%) for cities, thirty per cent (30%) for school districts and forty per cent (40%) for Dallas County and does hereby so case the City of Mesquite's vote.

SECTION 2. That the City Secretary shall send a certified copy of this Amendment of Westlation to the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Dallas County Appraisal District.

SECTION 3. That the Board of Directors of the Dallas County Appraisal District record this Amendment of Resolution as the vote and agreement of the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, to aren't Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 1 of said Resolution heretefore adopted concerning the method of allocation of the cost of operation of the Dallas County Appraisal District.

SECTION 4. SECTION 5. That a copy of this resolution be sent to each of the cities and school districts eligible to vote upon this question. That each taxing entity is hereby requested to cast their vote in the manner set forth by this resolution.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
