A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING A GRANT AGREEMENT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR ASSISTANCE IN THE PURCHASE OF THE PHIL L. HUDSON AIRPORT UNDER THE AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT AID PROGRAM, AND DESIGNATING C. K. DUGGINS AS THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ACT IN BEHALF OF THE CITY WITH REGARD TO GRANT MATTERS, AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite intends to purchase the Phil L. Budson Airport for the use and benefit of the citizens of Mesquite  ${\bf P}$ and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the airport owner intends to sell the Hudson Airport to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has offered to assist the City in the purchase of the Rudson Airport, and has made a grant offer and presented a grant agreement for consideration:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite hereby accepts the terms and conditions of the grant agreement offered by the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Development Aid Program.

SECTION 2. That C. K. Duggins, City Manager, be and is hereby designated as the chief executive officer and authorized official to act in behalf of the City in regard to the execution and implementation of the grant agreement and its terms, conditions and requirements.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the charter in such cases provides.
