A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A DRAINAGE EASEMENT FROM BRUNSWICK LANE TO PICADILLY THROUGH PROPERTY OWNED BY N. T. CARMICHAEL TO BE ACQUIRED IN REGARD TO THE SOUTHWEST MESQUITE DRAINAGE PROJECT AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS RESPONSIBLE OFFICER TO PERFORM CERTAIN ACTS IN CONNECTION WITH THIS ACQUISITION, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THE REOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has funded and constructed the Southwest Mesquite Drainage Project in the Sherwood Forest Addition; and

WHEREAS, the contemplated storm sewer from Brunswick Lane to Picadilly was deleted in the project's redesign; and

WHEREAS, this deletion is creating a drainage situation which needs correction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the property, generally described as a drainage easement from Brunswick Lane to Picadilly through property owned by W. T. Carmichael and more fully described in Exhibit "A" is the property to be acquired as an easement for drainage purposes.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby designated as the responsible officer for matters relating to the acquisition of said easement rights and in this capacity is authorized to:

- Select an appraiser and execute a contract for an appraisal of said easement
- b. Upon receipt of the appraisal, establish the appraisal amount as the amount of just compensation for the property.
- c. Submit the owner of the property a written offer to purchase in the amount of just compensation

SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
