It appearing that Bill Blackwood received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Council Member, Place 3, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1982, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that Phil Young received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Council Member, Place 4, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1982, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.


It appearing that John W. Childs received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Council Member, Place 5, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1982, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.


