RESOLUTION NO. 7-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF VOTES UPON THE ISSUE OF LEGALIZATION OF BINGO IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, an election was held on April 3, 1982, for the legalization of Bingo; and

WHEREAS, the City Council duly canvassed the election returns upon such issue; and

WHEREAS, upon canvassing such votes the City Council duly approved the results as 1532 votes "for" Bingo and 799 votes "against" Bingo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

That the election returns upon the issue of Bingo SECTION 1. are hereby approved as follows:

"For" Bingo "Against" Bingo

SECTION 2. That upon the issue of "For" or "Against" Bingo in the City of Mesquite as provided by State Law, the vote "For" carried and Bingo is hereby regalized in the City of Mesquite to the cost of provided by State Law. the extent provided by State Law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
