RESOLUTION NO. 23-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000 UNDER THE OLDER AMERICANS ACT, TITLE III-B AND DESIGNATING C.K. DUGGINS AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING REQUIRED ASSURANCES AND ACTING IN CONNECTION WITH SAID APPLICATION, AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite's elderly population is significantly increasing along with its needs; and

WHEREAS, there are funds available under Title III-B of the Older Americans Act to assist in establishing an Office on Aging for the City of Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, it is to the public interest of the citizens of the City of Mesquite that application be made for such funds:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the filing of an application is authorized for funds not exceeding \$25,000 under Title III-B of the Older Americans Act to the Dallas Area Agency on Aging on behalf of the City of Mesquite, Texas.


SECTION 2. That C.K. Duggins be and is hereby designated as Chief Executive Officer and authorized representative to act in connection with said application and to certify to all understandings and assurances required under said Act including but not limited to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P.L. 88-352) and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the Regulations of the Department of Health and Human Services (45 CFR, Part 80) issued pursuant to that Title, and other such assurances and understandings as may be required.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provided.
