RESOLUTION NO. 9-83

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR REQUESTING A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to continue the operation of the Youth Services unit within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is requesting fifthyear funding for such unit from the Governor's Office of General Counsel and Criminal Justice in the amount of \$6,846.00, and has authorized the expenditure of \$27,384.00 as the City's match in cash contribution; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City of Mesquite will endorse the continuance of this project based on availability of funds and the success of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That C. K. Duggins, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and Jim Prugel, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Fiscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving, and dispersing funds through the Governor's Office of General Counsel and Criminal Justice for this purpose.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
