

RESOLUTION NO. 16-83
CANVASS OF THE RETURNS
AND DECLARATION OF THE
RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS
ON APRIL 2, 1983
FOR THE ELECTION OF A
MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR
PLACES 1, 2 AND 6

WHEREAS, a City Election was held on April 2, 1983, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Council Members for each of the following places: Nos. 1, 2 and 6 for two (2) year terms; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council.

Culver received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Council Member, Place 1, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1983, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that Joe D. Goggans received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Council Member, Place 2, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1983, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Council Member, Place 6, it is necessary to call a run-off election to be held April 16, 1983, for the purpose of deciding between Vernie G. Erwin and Larry Watson for the Office of Council Member, Place 6.

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held April 2, 1983, shall become effective immediately after its passage.
