A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF 1964, AS AMENDED AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definitive procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority businesses shall have the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts when procuring construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That C. K. Duggins, City Manager is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Mesquite with the U.S. Department of Transportation, to aid in the financing of vehicles for elderly transportation services.

SECTION 2. That C. K. Duggins, City Manager is authorized to execute and file with such application an assurance orany other document required by the U. S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

SECTION 3. That C. K. Duggins. City Manager is authorized to furnish such additional information as the U.S. Department of Transportation may require in connection with the application or the project.
