RESOLUTION NO. 19-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REQUESTING THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION INSTALL A CONTINUOUS HIGHWAY ILLUMINATION SYSTEM ON INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 30 FROM THE CITY'S WEST CITY LIMITS TO WEST OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 635 AT THE EXPENSE OF THE STATE WITH OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE COSTS TO BE PAID BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT EFFECTING SAME, AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby request that the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation install a continuous highway illumination system on Interstate Highway 30 from the City's west City Limits to west of Interstate Highway 635, with the State assuming the total cost of installation and the City assuming the operating and maintenance costs thereof.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation to effect same.


SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect from and after its date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
