

RESOLUTION NO. 27-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL IN OBTAINING EXTENDED AREA PHONE SERVICE, OUTLINING THE ADVANTAGES OF THE SERVICE, AND REQUESTING THAT THE TEXAS PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION LOOK FAVORABLY ON THE CITY OF ROCKWALL'S REQUEST FOR EXTENDED AREA SERVICE, AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite considers that Rockwall is part of the Dallas Metroplex, and


