RESOLUTION NO. 31-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE REQUIRING THE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISEE TO MAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS IN THE OPERATIONAL STANDARDS OF THE MESQUITE SYSTEM AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Cable Television Advisory Board has recommended certain improvements in the operational standards of the Cable Television Franchisee; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that such improvements are needed to provide the minimum standard of operation provided by the franchise agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Warner Apex Cable Communications Company of Mesquite, franchisee of cable television in Mesquite, is hereby required to make the following enumerated improvements to its Mesquite System:

1. Provide sufficient personnel and equipment for the Mesquite System to respond to service complaints within three (3) days of receipt thereof.
2. Maintain the maintenance service log at a location within the City in order that it may be conveniently inspected by representatives of the City.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after the date of passage in accordance with the law in such cases provided.
