A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 6-85 TO PROVIDE FOR ABSENTEE VOTING TO BE CONDUCTED ON SATURDAY, MARCH 30, 1985, FROM 2:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 P.M. IN ADDITION TO THE REGULAR TIME SCHEDULE FOR ABSENTEE VOTING - MARCH 18 THROUGH APRIL 2 FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 5:00 P.M.; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 6-85 be amended to provide for absentee voting to be conducted on Saturday, March 30, 1985, from 2:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. in addition to the regular time schedule for absentee voting - March 18 through April 2 from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.; in all other respects to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon passage as the law in such case provides.
