RESOLUTION NO. 17-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REQUESTING THAT THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE CONSTRUCT ADDITIONAL POST OFFICE FACILITIES IN THE CITY AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas, and those areas adjacent to the City are areas of rapid growth, with the current population of the City of Mesquite alone at 100,000 plus the population of adjacent areas, and

WHEREAS, the projected population for the City of Mesquite in the year 2000 is 142,000; and


WHEREAS, the present post office facility is already overcrowded and inadequate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite respectfully requests that the United States Postal Service give priority to the addition of postal facilities by the construction of one or more additional separate full service post office facilities in the City.

SECTION 2. That this resolution take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
