WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite finds that the unregulated transportation of hazardous materials through the City of Mesquite and through the region represents a hazard to the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Mesquite and the region; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite supports developing a routing system based upon a technical and coordinated approach, and in doing so, enhances the safety of the entire area and not that of a single interest group or community; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments has determined from a technical analysis that the Regional Hazardous Materials Truck Routing Plan represents those routes with the least amount of risk to the public resulting from the shipment of hazardous materials through the metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the Texas State Department of Highways and Public Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration have approved the routing plan for hazardous materials truck shipments traveling through the metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Regional Hazardous Materials Truck Route is designated on $\underline{\text{I.635}}$ in the City of Mesquite.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:
