

## RESOLUTION NO. 35-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE 1986 GREATER DALLAS MOBILITY PLAN AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the best interest of the citizens of Mesquite can be served by the equitable apportionment of State funds for construction of transportation facilities, and

WHEREAS, in many areas of Mesquite, the ever-growing demand for mobility exceeds the supply of transportation facilities, and

WHEREAS, City Officials have participated in the assimilation of transportation needs for the metroplex, as presented in the 1986 Greater Dallas Mobility Plan, and


WHEREAS, the Metroplex Mayors' Committee has initiated a lobbying effort to present the Mobility Plan to the State Highway Commission, and request that the metroplex receive its fair share of funding for transportation facilities,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite does hereby endorse and support the 1986 Greater Dallas Mobility Plan.
