RESOLUTION NO. 21-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS SUSPENDING THE OPERATION OF THE PROPOSED RATE INCREASE FILED BY LONE STAR GAS COMPANY FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY (90) DAYS BEYOND THE DATE ON WHICH SUCH RATE SCHEDULE WOULD OTHERWISE GO INTO EFFECT; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE HEREOF TO SAID PUBLIC UTILITY.

WHEREAS, Lone Star Gas Company did, on May 15, 1987, file a proposed rate for gas service within the City of Mesquite to become effective June 22, 1987; and

WHEREAS, after having considered the presentation of Lone Star Gas Company, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Mesquite that such proposed rate schedule should be suspended for a period of 90 days from June 22, 1987, for further study, investigation, presentation of evidence and public hearing; and

WHEREAS, notice of this resolution has been provided to Lone Star Gas Company.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

PART 1. Pursuant to Section 4(d) of the Public Utility Regulatory Act, the operation of the proposed rate increase filed with the City of Mesquite on May 15, 1987, by Lone Star Gas Company, is hereby suspended for a period of 90 days from June 22, 1987, for further study, investigation, presentation of evidence and public hearing.

PART 2. That the City Manager is authorized to retain any and all personnel necessary to examine the proposed rate change.

PART 3. That the City Manager is authorized to notify Lone Star Gas Company that the proposed increase is hereby suspended for ninety (90) days.
