NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code provides for the general election for election of City Officers to be held the first Saturday in May, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Mesquite wishes to relocate the polling place for Precincts 2284, 2294, 2303 and 2316, for economic reasons and for the convenience of its citizens.


SECTION 1. The polling place for the City of Mesquite's Precincts numbered 2284, 2294, 2303 and 2316 is relocated from Beasley Elementary School at 919 Green Canyon Drive to Scott Dunford Community Center at 1015 Green Canyon Drive.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be in effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.



SECTION 2. This resolution shall be in effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.


