RESOLUTION NO. 5-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANTS PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANTS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite desires to develop a viable urban community, including the expansion of the quantity and improvement of the quality of emergency shelters for the homeless; and


WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the health and safety of the homeless; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Mesquite to apply for funding under the 1988 Texas Emergency Shelter Grants Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Emergency Shelter Grants Program application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Community Affairs.
2. That the City's application be placed in competition for funding under the Emergency Shelter Grants Fund.
3. That the application be for \$200,000.00 of grant funds to carry out the rehabilitation of Mesquite Shelter for the Homeless.
4. That the City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the application and the City's participation in the Texas Emergency Shelter Grants Program.
5. That it further be stated that the City of Mesquite is committing to the donation of the use of portions of the Mesquite Social Service Building and to the contribution of operating funds and that the combined value of such commitment is \$200,000.00.


