A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING MAYOR GEORGE A. VENNER, SR. TO ENTER IN-TO A INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR A ROUTE ALIGNMENT STUDY; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Garland, Mesquite, Rowlett, hereinafter "Cities", and the County of Dallas, hereinafter 'County', desires to enter into an agreement for a Route Alignment Study for the extension and development of SH-190 in the cities and county between SH-78 in Garland and (H-20 in Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, the Cities and County hereby agree to participate equally in the funding of this Route Alignment Study in the amount of \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Article 4413 (32c) Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, authorizes local governments to contract with one or more focal governments to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the interest of the City of Mesquite, to enter into such agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Mayor George A. Venner, Sr. of the City of Mesquite is hereby authorized to enter into a interlocal agreement for a Route Alignment Study in the amount of \$200,000.

SECTION 2. That this resolution take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
