RESOLUTION NO _41-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, URGING THE LEGISLATURE TO AMEND CHAPTER 252 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE. (FORMERLY, TEX REV. CIV. STAT. ANN. ART. 2368a) TO ALLOW CITIES TO PURCHASE USED EQUIPMENT AT GOING-OUT-OF-BUSINESS SALES, LIQUIDATION SALES, SPECIALLY CALLED SALES AND OTHER SIMILAR SALES WHERE EQUIPMENT CAN BE PURCHASED FOR LIMITED PERIODS OF TIME AT GREATLY REDUCED PRICES, AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Chapter 252 of the Local Government Code (formerly, Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann. art. 2368a) requires municipalities with a population of 50,000 or more to comply with procedures for competitive bidding when entering into contracts requiring expenditures exceeding \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, used equipment becomes available for purchase for limited periods of time at liquidation, going-out-of-business, and other similar sales; and

WHEREAS, the ability of cities to purchase equipment at such timited time, sales would result in substantial savings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite urges the legislature to amend Chapter 252 of the Local Government Code (formerly, Tex. Rev. City. Stal. Ann. art 2368a) to except from the requirements of competitive bidding, used equipment which can be purchased at greatly reduced prices for timited periods of time at going-out-of-business sales, liquidation sales, specially called sales and other similar sales when the governing body has budgeted for and funds have been appropriated for such equipment.

<u>SECTION</u> 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
