

RESOLUTION NO. 45-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING TRANSFER OF CONDITIONS FROM FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANT NUMBERS 3-48-0147-03 AND 3-48-0147-04 TO FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANT NO. 3-48-0307-07-88, AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration is offering to the City a grant No. 3-48-0307-07-88; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to agree to the transfer of requirements from grant numbers 3-48-0147-03 and 3-48-0147-04;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS.

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite hereby agrees to the transfer of conditions from Federal Aviation Administration Grant Numbers 3-48-0147-03 and 3-48-0147-04 as amendments to Federal Aviation Administration Grant Number 3-48-0307-07-88 as follows.

1. It is understood and agreed that Sponsor will within one (1) year of the acceptance of this Grant, acquire (with or without Federal Assistance) fee simple title or other property interests satisfactory to the Administrator in such land as is necessary for the establishment of a clear zone outward from the south end of Runway 17-35, symmetrically located with respect to the extended runway centerline, such clear zone being 1,700' long, having a width of 500' at a point 200' from the runway end, and flaring uniformly outward to a width of 1,010' at a point 1,900' from the runway end, or other areas satisfactory to the Administrator.
2. It is understood and agreed that the United States will not make any payment under this Grant Agreement until the Sponsor has removed or caused to be removed any growth, structure, or other object within the runway approach at the north end of Runway 17-35 which would be a hazard to the landing, taking-off, or maneuvering of aircraft at the airport. The airport approach standards to be followed in performing the covenants contained in this paragraph shall be those established by the Administrator in Part 77 of the Federal Aviation Regulations unless otherwise authorized by the Administrator. Such standards applicable have been determined to be clearing of said approach to a 34:1 obstruction clearance slope.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
