

RESOLUTION NO. 48-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, A TAXING UNIT ENTITLED TO VOTE ON THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE DALLAS CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT, CHANGING THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE DALLAS CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT, TO BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, the Texas Property Tax Code establishes an appraisal district in each county and provides a calendar fiscal year for the operation of such District; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.06 (i) of the Texas Property Tax Code provides that the governing bodies of three-fourths of the taxing units entitled to vote on the appointment of board members of the appraisal district's board of directors may change the fiscal year of the District; and

WHEREAS, the current fiscal year of the Dallas Central Appraisal District is January 1 through December 31 of each calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Central Appraisal District Board of Directors is desirous of changing the fiscal year date and voted on September 7, 1988 to recommend that the fiscal year of the operation and financing of the Dallas Central Appraisal District be changed as set out hereinafter; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas is a taxing unit entitled to vote on the appointment of members to the Board of Directors of the Dallas Central Appraisal District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the fiscal year for the operation of the Dallas Central Appraisal District be changed to a September 1 through August 31 fiscal year beginning September 1, 1989.

SECTION 2. That the Dallas Central Appraisal District amend its 1989 Annual Budget to reflect the new fiscal year change.

SECTION 3. That each taxing unit shall pay its allocation as provided by Subsection (c) of Section 6.06 of the Texas Property Tax Code, except that the first payment shall be made before the first day of the fiscal year established by the change and subsequent payments shall be made quarterly.

SECTION 4. That any Resolution heretofore adopted covering any other fiscal year for the operation of the Dallas Central Appraisal District is hereby revoked and rescinded.

SECTION 5. That the City of Mesquite, Texas shall send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Dallas Central Appraisal District.

SECTION 6. That the Board of Directors of the Dallas Central Appraisal District record this Resolution as the vote of the City Council of the City of Mesquite to change the fiscal year for the operation of the Dallas Central Appraisal District.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
