

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CONSENTING TO THE CITY OF DALLAS LEVYING ASSESSMENTS AGAINST CERTAIN PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF MESQUITE ABUTTING THE PROPOSED RECONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT OF JOHN WEST ROAD BETWEEN BUCKNER BOULEVARD AND LAPRADA DRIVE/BIG TOWN BOULEVARD.

WITEREAS, the City of Dallas proposes to reconstruct and improve John West Road between Buckner-Boulevard and LaPrada Drive/Big Town Boulevard and seeks to assess abutting properties specially benefited by the improvement a portion of the cost of said improvement project; and

WHEREAS, certain properties abutting the proposed street improvement project are located within the corporate limits of Mesquite, and said properties are likely to be specially benefited by the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite recognizes in the proposed street improvement project substantial benefit to the motoring public in the elimination of traffic congestion and the enhancement of traffic salety, as well as the prospect of special benefit to abutting property owners;

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas has requested permission from the City of Mesquite to assess said properties in Mesquite abutting the proposed street improvement project a portion of the cost of said improvement project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.— That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, does hereby agree to consent to the City of Dallas levying an assessment against certain properties located within the corporate limits of Mesquite which abut the proposed improvement by the City of Dallas, Texas, of John West Road between Bucknet Bucknet and LaPrada Drive/Big Town Boulevard in accordance with State Statute; provided, however, that the specific assessment amounts proposed to be levied against said properties shall be subject to approval and ratification by the City of Mesquite.
