If no response is made to the final offer within thirty (30) days, the Attorney for the SECTION 3. City is hereby authorized to institute Eminent Domain proceedings to condemn said property for said use according to law and to obtain fee simple title to and upon said property for the purposes expressed herein.

SECTION 4. Should any portion of the property described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, not be subject to legal condemnation by the City of Mesquite, such fact shall not prevent the City from condemning such land which is described in Exhibit "A" and is subject to legal condemnation by the City, and it is the intention of the City of Mesquite to condemn only such territory as may be legally condemned by it within the legal to the legal territory in the City of Mesquite to the state of the legal territory as may be legally condemned by it within the limits of the land described in Exhibit "A".
