RESOLUTION NO. 56-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ACKNOWLEDGING THE LAWFUL ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CLASSIFICATIONS OF ASSISTANT POLICE CHIEF, AND ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF AND THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS IN EACH OF THESE CLASSIFICATIONS, AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE AND FIRE CHIEFS TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VACANCIES AT THE ASSISTANT CHIEF LEVEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 143 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND RATIFYING ALL SUCH APPOINTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission has provided for the classification of all fire fighters and police officers; and


WHEREAS, provided for within the Fire Department is the classification of Assistant Fire Chief, with the number of positions in such classification having been prescribed, in accordance with Law, at one (1), and provided for within the Police Department is the classification of Assistant Police Chief, the number of positions in such classification having been prescribed, in accordance with Law, at two (2).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the Fire Chief and the Chief of Police are authorized to appoint persons to the lawfully established positions of Assistant Fire Chief, such positions numbering one (1), and Assistant Police Chief, such positions numbering two (2), in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 143 of the Local Government Code, and the appointment of persons to these positions is hereby ratified.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
