RESOLUTION NO. 26-83

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS URGING THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE TO SUPPORT LEGISLATION AMENDING TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. AND ARTY. 6.2, CRIM. MAKING IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE FOR AN OPERATOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO FAIL TO CARRY PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY WITH THEM WHEN OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE.

WHEREAS, The Texas Legislature has enacted Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Art. Article 6701b making it a criminal offense for an operator of a motor vehicle to fail to maintain financial responsibility when operating a vehicle; and

WHEREAS, an Attorney General's opinion No. AG-97 pronounced collection of an administrative fee or reparation of motor vehicles that failed to carry proof of financial responsibility and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General did state that "The legislature remains free to make the failure to carry proof of financial responsibility when operating a motor vehicle a crime"; and

WHEREAS, the failure of motor vehicle operators to carry proof of financial responsibility with them when operating a motor vehicle increases the cost to cities of enforcement of the Statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite urges the Texas Municipal League to support legislation amending Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Art. Article 6701b making it a criminal offense for an operator of a motor vehicle to fail to carry proof of financial responsibility with them when operating a motor vehicle.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter so provides.
