RESOLUTION NO. 28-89

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS URGING THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE TO SUPPORT LEGISLATION AMENDING CHAPTER 252 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE (FORMERLY, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ANN. ART. 2368a) TO ALLOW CITIES TO PURCHASE USED EQUIPMENT AT GOING OUT OF BUSINESS SALES, LIQUIDATION SALES, SPECIALLY CALLED SALES AND OTHER SIMILAR SALES WHERE EQUIPMENT CAN BE PURCHASED FOR LIMITED PERIODS OF TIME AT GREATLY REDUCED PRICES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 252 of the Local Government Code (formerly, Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann. Art. 2368a) requires municipalities with a population of 50,000 or more to comply with procedures for competitive bidding when entering into contract requiring expenditures exceeding \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, used equipment becomes available for purchase for limited periods of time at liquidation, going out of business, and other similar sales; and


WHEREAS, the ability of cities to purchase equipment at such limited sales would result in substantial savings;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite urges the Texas Municipal League to support legislation amending Chapter 252 of the Local Government Code (formerly, Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann. Art. 2368a) to except from the requirements of competitive bidding, used equipment which can be purchased at greatly reduced prices for limited periods of time at going-out-of-business sales, liquidation sales, specially called sales and other similar sales when the governing body has budgeted and appropriated funds for such equipment.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides;
