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RESOLUTION NO. 38-89

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REQUESTING THAT DALLAS COUNTY TRANSFER THE SURPLUS BOND FUNDS FROM SAMUELL BOULEVARD PROJECT, WHICH RUNS FROM BUCKNER BOULEVARD TO BIG TOWN BOULEVARD, TO BRUTON ROAD PROJECT, WHICH RUNS FROM LBJ FREEWAY TO PIONEER ROAD; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Dallas County's 1985 Bond Program included the design and construction of paving and drainage improvements on Samuell Boulevard from Buckner Boulevard to Big Town Boulevard with \$2,600,000.00 in funding, and Bruton Road from LBJ to Pioneer Road with \$3,000,000.00 in funding; and

WHEREAS, both the Samuell Boulevard project and the Bruton Road project's design are complete, and the latest cost estimates for these projects reveal surplus funds for Samuell Boulevard and a shortfall of funds for Bruton Road; and


WHEREAS, it is considered that the best interests of the City of Mesquite and County of Dallas will be served by a re-allocation of all surplus funds from the Samuell Boulevard project to the Bruton Road project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite hereby requests that the surplus funds from the Samuell Boulevard project be allocated to the Bruton Road project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
