

RESOLUTION NO. 42-89

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE AIRPORT MANAGER TO ADVERTISE AND CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS AT THE PHIL L. HUDSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration requires that an Environmental Assessment be performed as a condition for the expenditure of federal funds toward further expansion of the Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Charles Willis and Associates, Inc., has been authorized by the City Council to undertake preparation of said Environmental Assessment; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the Environmental Assessment, it is necessary to conduct a public hearing to receive input from interested persons regarding the proposed improvements at Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:



SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.


