

RESOLUTION NO. 06-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ENDORSING THE CONCEPT OF A 2,000 FOOT EXTENSION OF THE RUNWAY AND TAXIWAY AT PHIL L. HUDSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT AND DESIGNATING AND AUTHORIZING JAMES A. PRUGEL, JR., CITY MANAGER, TO ACT IN BEHALF OF THE CITY TO REQUEST FEDERAL FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is dedicated to the development and improvement of Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, federal funding may be requested for airport improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

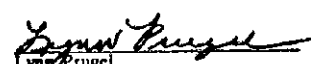
SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, endorses the concept of lengthening the runway and taxiway at the Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport by 2,000 feet and the construction of a ramp of the same load capacity.

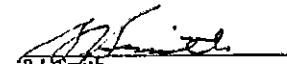
SECTION 2. That James A. Prugel, Jr., City Manager, be and is hereby authorized and designated to act in behalf of the City in regard to requesting federal funds for the project and agreeing to the terms, conditions and requirements of the federal funding if such funding is offered.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
