A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF TISEO PAVING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,395,351.80 FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF SAMUELL BLVD. FROM TOWN EAST BLVD. TO CITY LIMITS
AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING MAYOR GEORGE A VENNER,
SR. TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMENTAL CITY/COUNTY AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE MAXIMUM FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,436,043.83 AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas, and the County of Dallas, Texas, wish to enter into an Agreement for the construction of City's traffic and transportation related facilities and adjustment of water and sanitary sewer services located along and parallel to Samuell Blvd. between Town East Blvd. and City Limits and to expand from a two lane road to a six-lane divided thoroughfare; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Article 4413 (32c) Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, provides authorization for any local government to contract with one or more local governments to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE,

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, does hereby accept the low bid of \$3,395,351.80 for reconstruction of Samuell Blvd. from Town East Blvd. to City Limits and further authorized Mayor George A. Venner, Sr. to enter into a supplemental City/County Agreement to provide funding in the amount of \$1,436,043.83 which will be the City of Mesquite's participation in the project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon the date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
